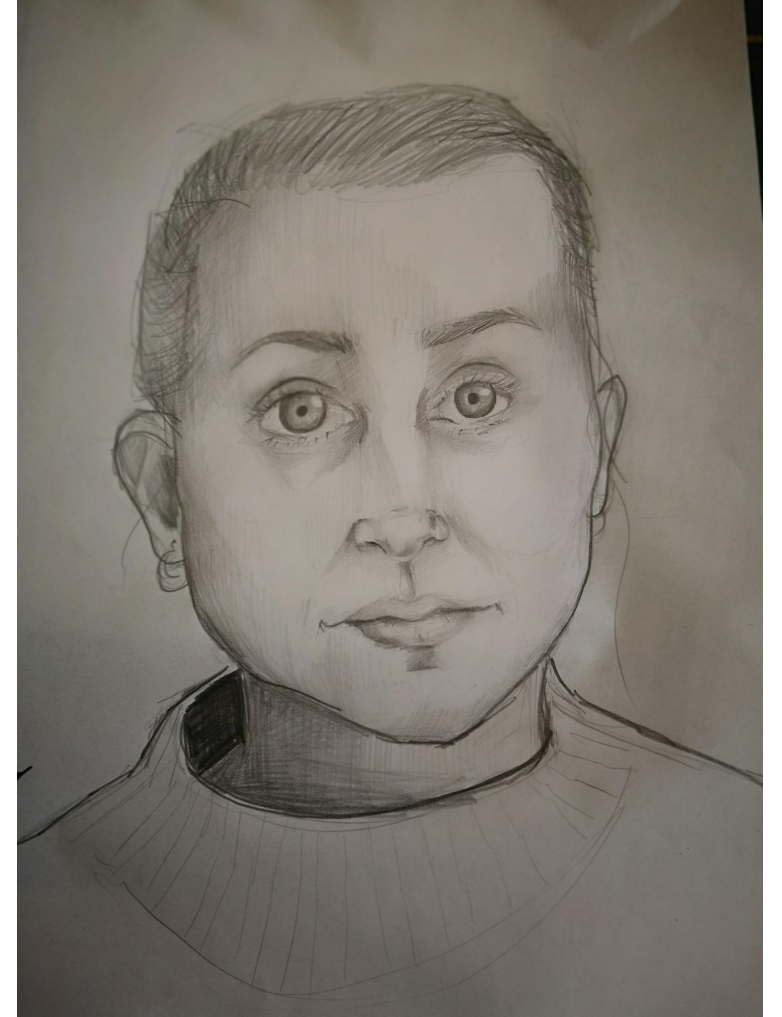
Process
